COMPLAINT PROCEDURES

Effective May 22, 1991, the Iowa Utilities Commission passed a ruling requiring all non-rate regulated utilities to post the following notice to its membership:

If a member has a question or concern regarding his/her electric service, please write or call Franklin Rural Electric Cooperative at 1560 Highway 65, PO Box 437, Hampton, Iowa, 50441–0437 or 641–456–2557. Office hours are Monday through Friday, 6:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. from Memorial Day to Labor Day and 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Labor Day to Memorial Day.
