

Round up your bill to help others

What is *Operation RoundUp*®?

Operation RoundUp® is a program that allows Franklin REC consumer-owners to make a difference in their own communities. *Operation RoundUp*® allows you to “round-up” your monthly electric bills and donate the difference to a charitable fund to be used in Franklin REC’s service territory. The minimum amount you contribute each month is \$0.01 and the maximum is \$0.99. The average donation is \$6.00 per year.



How does *Operation RoundUp*® work?

If you choose to participate, your electric bill will be rounded-up to the next highest dollar each month. For example, if your electric bill is \$52.71, an additional balance of 29 cents will be added, making your bill an even \$53.00.

How will the funds be used?

Donations are made from the fund to non-profit organizations and individuals in need and also for family emergency disasters. The program has been successfully implemented in more than 200 electric co-ops across the nation. The program is administered by Franklin REC’s board of directors. Application forms are available at the REC office and will be reviewed by the Board of Directors monthly. Contributions to the fund are not tax deductible.

By joining with other Franklin REC members, your small monthly donation can make a bigger impact. It’s what a cooperative is all about.
